

Primary Maths Subject Leader Development Project

Schools are invited to be part of this NNW Maths Hub project, aimed at informing and inspiring Primary Maths Subject Leaders. Attendance involves committing to 2 full days' training, led by invited Mathematics Consultant, Louise Pennington. Subject Leaders will be able to take back to their schools innovative, valuable ideas and key messages to help raise attainment and increase pupils' enjoyment of mathematics.

There will be a requirement to complete a gap task and submit a short reflection detailing impact on your own school at the end of the training.

The course is offered *free of charge* but there is an expectation that schools will cover supply costs.

Day 1

Improving Pupils' Reasoning Skills with Geometry and Measures

Thursday 13th February 2020 – 9.30am to 4.00pm

Developing reasoning about shape, angles, position and direction and designing rich problem-solving and reasoning tasks to promote pupils' confidence in converting units of measurement, area & perimeter and volume. A gap task will be set to feed back on during Day 2 training.

Day 2

Improving Outcomes for Low Attaining and Disadvantaged Pupils – practical Mastery Approaches

Tuesday 9th June 2020 – 9.30am to 4.00pm

The day will also include updates from DfE and Ofsted. As a group, SL's will have opportunities to network and share new professional learning practices resulting from Day 1 training, assessing positive impact and identifying next steps for their own schools.
